

Fire Ban Info (Updated 3/10/2026):

The 2018 San Isabel Forest Fire Ban is no longer in effect.

As of March 2026, fire danger ranges from Low to Very High across the Pike-San Isabel National Forests (specifically the San Carlos Ranger District), with some areas under active fire restrictions.

Costilla County:

Fire restrictions in Costilla County are **automatically enacted during Red Flag Warnings** issued by the National Weather Service. A full fire ban (prohibiting all open fires and fireworks) is in effect during these warnings. For the most current status, contact the **Costilla County Sheriff's Office** directly.

Alamosa County:

Alamosa County also **automatically enacts fire restrictions during Red Flag Warnings**. Open fires and fireworks are prohibited under these conditions. Check the latest updates via the **Alamosa County Sheriff's Office** or the official Colorado Emergency Management Fire Restrictions map.

General Guidance:

- Use the **Colorado Emergency Management Fire Restrictions Map** (coemergency.com) for real-time county-level updates.
- Always verify with the **local sheriff's office** or **state emergency website** before outdoor burning, as conditions change rapidly.
